One-on-one assignments intended to strengthen and support children and youth by:

- Preventing, reducing, or eliminating behaviors which may place the child, family or community at risk
- Preventing out of home placements
- Improving individual functioning, and ability to cope in social settings
- Engaging in social and recreational activities
- Providing support, supervision and encouragement in activities

Qualifications:

- Ability to establish rapport with children and youth
- Sensitivity and respect for individual needs and values
- A clear, Criminal Record Check
- The ability to work flexible hours, primarily evenings and weekends
- Related education and a minimum of 3 years' experience working with children and the vulnerable sector
- Must be able to commit to a minimum of 6 months
- Ability to work independently and as a team
- Experience in record keeping and reporting

Duties:

- Maintain constant communication with Program Coordinator
- Attend regular training and staff meetings
- Research and involve children in age appropriate, healthy community activities
- Provide monthly reports
- Other duties as assigned by Program Coordinator
