We specialize in Domestic Adoption, defined as the adoption of a Saskatchewan child by a Saskatchewan person or family. However, Evermore provides resources and guidance for those exploring other forms of adoption and permanency. We also offer webinars and information in preparation for parenting an adopted child.

Parents & Caregivers

If you are a parent or caregiver in need of support, you are not alone. Evermore provides supports and programs to adoptive and permanent families. Transitions for children and adults can be exciting as well as challenging. Birth Parents

Confidential, non-judgmental support to safely explore your options. Individuals of any age, ethnicity, religious affiliation, economic status, or marital status can be faced with making challenging decisions associated with an unplanned pregnancy. Birth parents may find themselves in a position where they are unable to parent their child or may choose, in the best interests of the child, not to parent.

At The Evermore Centre, we help answer questions about adoption, explain how adoption works today, help you understand your rights and your ability to control and make choices in adoption planning. We can also assist you with referrals to other services that may be of help to you.

If you are a birth parent who made an adoption plan and wish to talk about your adoption experience, we can connect you with a support network or offer consultation services.

Adoptees

Over a lifetime, adoptees may experience a wide variety of emotions and feelings about adoption. Most adoptees will experience curiosity about their adoption and will have questions. Developmental and socioemotional changes at various ages and stages over a lifetime will bring about different feelings and emotions connected to being an adoptee. These experiences will be unique for every adoptee. Each and every adoptee has the right to know they are adopted and they also have the right to explore and ask questions surrounding their adoption.
