Foundations Learning & Skills Saskatchewan (formerly READ Saskatoon) offers free literacy services to adults and their families and promotes literacy awareness, partnerships and development through adult tutoring, family literacy programs and events, and money management workshops.

They have four program areas:

1. **Family Literacy:** Fun and family-centered programs and events for children and their parents/caregivers. Programs include songs and rhymes, story time, literacy crafts and activities, and parent information. A snack and take-home book are provided. Workshops for parents on language and early reading are also available.
2. **Adult Literacy:** One-to-one tutoring, small group, and large group workshops for adults to improve reading, writing, comprehension, listening, speaking, and/or spelling skills for education, employment, and/or personal self-identified goals.
3. **Financial Literacy:** Money management workshops to build financial knowledge, skills and confidence. Topics include budgeting, banking, credit and debt management, asset building, and spending habits. RESP, Frauds & Scams, and Tax Basics presentations are also available.
4. **Children's Literacy:** School-based program that works with children in grades 2-4 who are reading below grade level and workshops for parents to learn how to support child's reading and writing at home.

They also offer workshops to strengthen writing skills and evaluation practices and provide training in all four program areas to grow literacy skills in your community.
